Chairman Gareth Lee opened the meeting by welcoming the guest speaker for the night Wayne Knight who was a Clinical Nurse Manager with the HSE. He spoke of the importance of raising awareness of mental health issues and encouraged members of the community to engage with the services provided by the HSE in the area.

Chairman Gareth Lee gave a summary of areas the community council had been involved with in the previous year.
